With reference to the subject cited above it is hereby directed to destroy all poisons namely:-

- (a) Atropine Sulphate - 1 x 8.484 g.
- (b) Brucine - 2 x 5.0 g.
1 x 10 g.
- (c) Homatropine - 1 x 5.0 g.
- (d) Mercuric Chloride - 1 x 330.0 g.
1 x 250.0 g.
- (e) Picric acid - 1 x 500.0 g.
1 x 10.5 g.
- (d) Pot. Chlorate - 3 x 250.0 g.
- (e) Pot. Cyanide - 2 x 250.0 g.
1 x 100 g.
- (f) p-Arsamillic acid - 3 x 25.0 g.
- (g) Strychnine sulphate - 1 x 25.0 g.
1 x 10.49 g.
- (h) Sod. Arsenite - 2 x 100.0 g.
- (i) Sod. Cyanide - 1 x 200.0 g.
- (f) Scopalamine hydrochloride - 1 x 1.0 g.

As mentioned in the affidavit. This must be done with taking all the necessary precautions, and permission from competent Govt. authority / authorities (if requires).

It is also directed that, the whole process of destruction must be Videographed from start to end and a CD of the same must be handed over to DC/RF office for future evidence.
